General information

Erasmus+ is the European Union programme for education, training, youth and sport for the period 2014-2020. It offers a range of opportunities for higher education students, doctoral candidates, staff and institutions from around the world. Please read an overview of ERASMUS+ programme for student and staff mobility that is given in a separate document called "Erasmus+ What's in it for higher education? An introduction for students, teachers and staff in higher education".

VNU University of Science (VNU-HUS) and Greifswald University (GREIF) have signed Inter-Institutional Agreements to cooperate for the exchange of students and staff in the context of the Erasmus+ programme. We commit to respect the quality requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education in all aspects related to the organisation and management of the mobility, in particular the recognition of the credits (or equivalent) awarded to students by the partner institution through Erasmus+

Academic requirements

During the semester studies abroad, 30 ECTS credit points in English must be obtained for courses at GREIF. At the time of application, student's Study plan abroad is indicative and will be modified (if necessary) and approved before the actual mobility.

The courses successfully completed at the GREIF will be transferred (through process of academic recognition) to the VNU-HUS and will substitute relevant VNU-HUS courses.

Eligibility and selection criteria

1. Students (prioritize PhD. Students) with a scientific background in Earth sciences (visit the following link for the offered courses https://www.uni-

greifswald.de/storages/uni-

greifswald/4 International/4.1 Incomings/4.1.2 Erasm us und Austausch weltweit/Vorlesungsverzeichnis Anleitung 2019.pdf) with:

- Good academic performance: 60%
- Motivation (English): 20%.
- Relevance of the proposal: 20%
- No missing payments of VNU-HUS tuition fees; No disciplinary sanctions within the past 6 months.
- 2. PhD. Student should find a scientist from GREIF to work as co-supervisor for his/her research.

Proficiency of English is not a selection criterion but a requirement sine qua non.

Study plan with specified course titles in host partner institution will be evaluated.

- Demonstrated extracurricular activity involvement in promotion campaigns, Erasmus+ special events, Student Association, NGOs, scientific research projects) and knowledge Spanish is a plus.
- With equivalent academic level, preference should be assigned to applicants from less advantaged socioeconomic backgrounds

Grant support for the mobility

Travel: 1500 euros

Stipend: 850 euros/month

Process of mobility

1. Applicant first makes an application at VNU-HUS within the announced Call; 2. Selection Committee reviews all applications, selects the applicant for Erasmus+ mobility; 3. VNU-HUS Erasmus+ coordinator informs the GREIF of nominated VNU-HUS student: 4. Each applicant is notified individually about the selection results; 5. Selected student then may proceed with registration at the partner university. GREIF provide practical information about housing, insurance etc.; 6. Individual grant agreements and Mobility Agreements are being prepared and signed (GREIF, VNU-HUS, Student); 7. Student makes his/her own travel arrangements and begins mobility; 8. Learning agreement is finalized in the 1st month of the study semester abroad; 9. A short mid-term progress report from VNU-HUS students may be required after 2 months of studies; 10. Before the end of mobility the student must obtain confirmation letter about the period of studies at the host university; 11. At the end of mobility, the student will submit final evaluation. 12. Transcript from GREIF is sent to VNU-HUS and the student within 5 weeks after the final exams; 13. Student submits a form for "academic recognition" of courses at VNU-HUS: 14. VNU-HUS undertakes the process of academic recognition of the students and send proof of recognition to GREIF. 15. VNU-HUS and GREIF start activities of dissemination of results.
